School Safe Driving Program

## TO Parents of Culver City High School 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade Students,

Did you know that traffic collisions are the leading cause of death among teenagers? Culver City High School in conjunction with Streetwise Media, will be presenting the powerful ***In One Instant*** teen safe driving program during school hours on May 29th.

***In One Instant*** is a peer-driven experiential program that challenges each student to participate and understand the impact their decisions have on family, friends and community. Delivered through a dramatic reenactment of reckless driving due to drinking, texting and cell phone use, the program demonstrates how one wrong decision *-in one instant-* can have lifelong consequences. It involves teens on a profoundly emotional level and resonates long after the program concludes. ***In One Instant*** works effectively within the demanding school schedule and utilizes very little teacher time.

### PROGRAM INCLUDES:

- Driving Behaviors Pre and Post Program Survey.
- Crashed car positioned on campus, creating a crash scene.
- Memorial Assembly with several peer-driven interactive components.
- Award winning film (winner of 3 Telly Awards); additional multi-media elements.
- Guest speaker.
- After the program, all students are required to: Look through last texts and decide which one was worth risking a life, asked to commit to a safe driving pledge.
- Counselor Support Services available on campus for follow up.
